# Draw:

- 8am first games
- No on-site Tech Meeting, just these notes
- Full scoring (21,21,15)
- There will be a rolling draw, with strictly 10min between matches
  - For each 5mins a team is late for their match they will forfeit a set (this applies to duty teams also, who will forfeit set(s) from their next match)
- Duty all duties are assigned to team competing. Late penalties also apply to duty team's
- Scoresheets
